
DESCRIPTION

This document illustrates how to replace a Motor Service Kit for models 620,621, JJ501, and JJ502W.





TOOLS NEEDED

- #2 Phillips Screw Driver
- 10mm Socket Wrench or Driver
- Pliers

PARTS INCLUDED






UNPLUG UNIT FROM OUTLET AND ALLOW TO COOL

- Remove (8) Screws from the back of the unit; remove the back.
- Open the oven door. Once opened, loosen or remove support screws. Once loose, remove support racks
- Remove (4) screws to the panel covering the fan; Remove the panel.
- Using the 10mm socket, remove the nut that is attached to the fan; remove the fan.





- Remove the motor from the back of the oven and separate the insulation discs from the motor.



Remove wires connected to the motor. Using the new motor, complete all steps in reverse order & you have successfully replaced your units blower motor. Your unit is now ready for operation.
