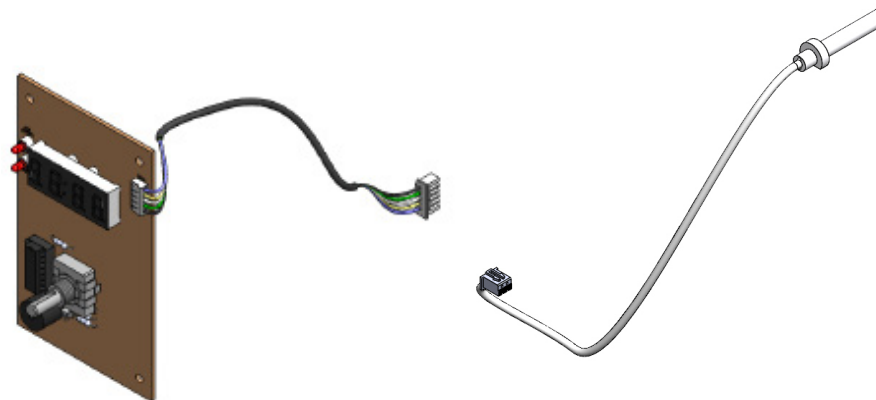
DESCRIPTION

TOOLS NEEDED

- #2 Phillips Screwdriver (Stubby Recommended)
- 11 mm Socket Wrench or Driver

- 0027818 - Temperature Sensor

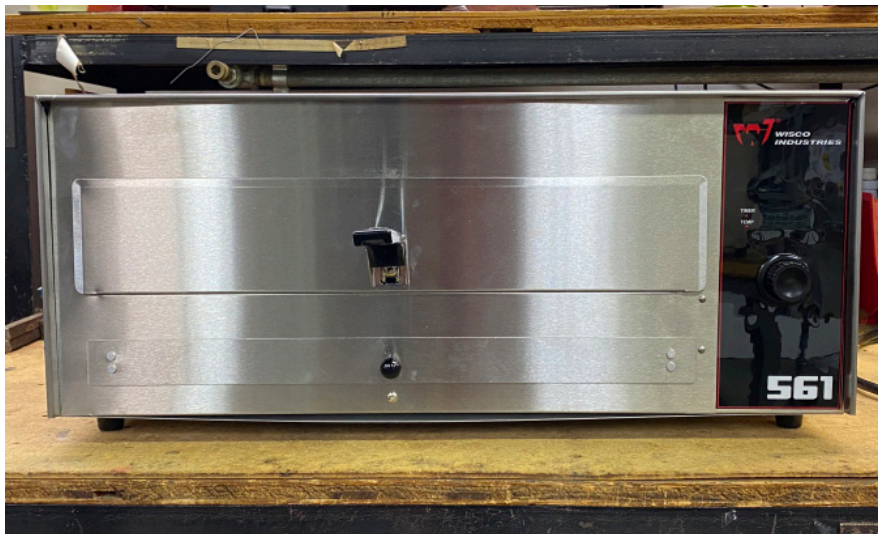

UNPLUG UNIT FROM OUTLET AND ALLOW TO COOL

- 1 Remove the grill and clean out tray from the unit.



- 2 Pull the control knob off of the faceplate. Using the 11 mm socket wrench or driver, remove the nut holding the control board to the faceplate.



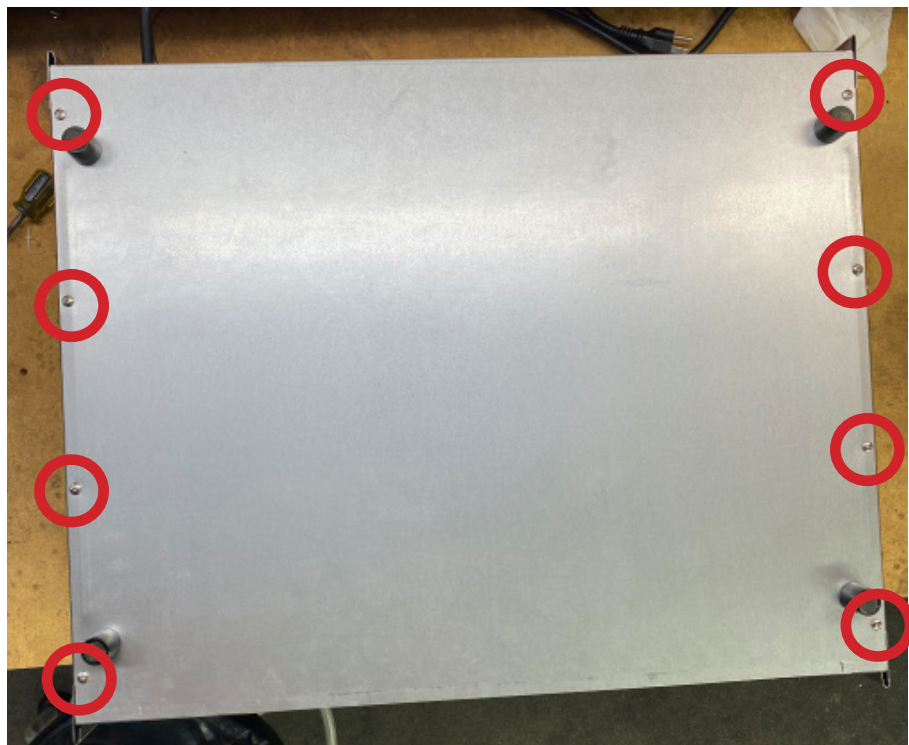

- 3** Flip the unit over and remove (8) screws from the bottom panel.



- 4** Remove (3) screws from the rear of the unit of the unit and then remove the bottom panel.



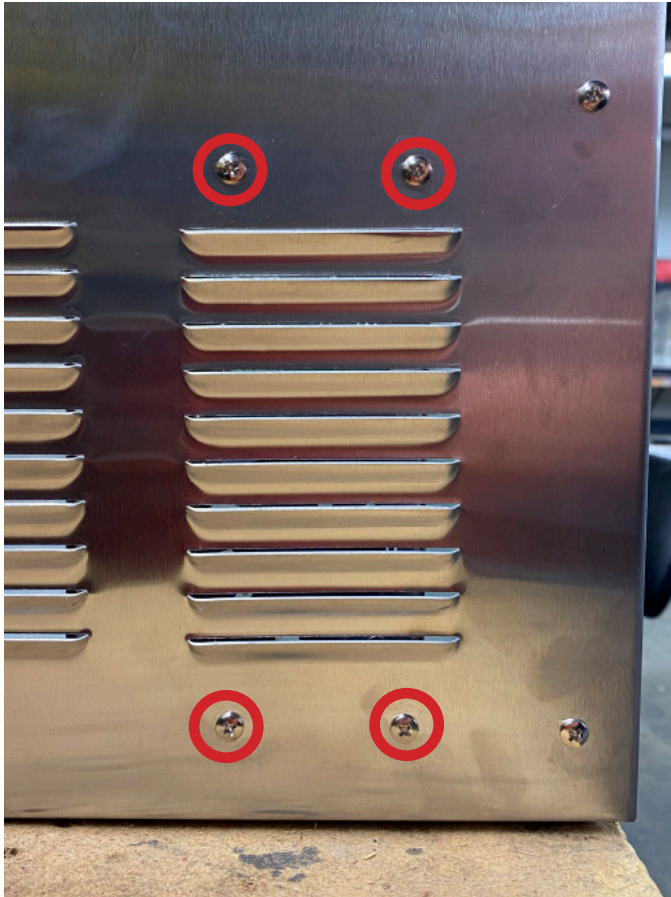

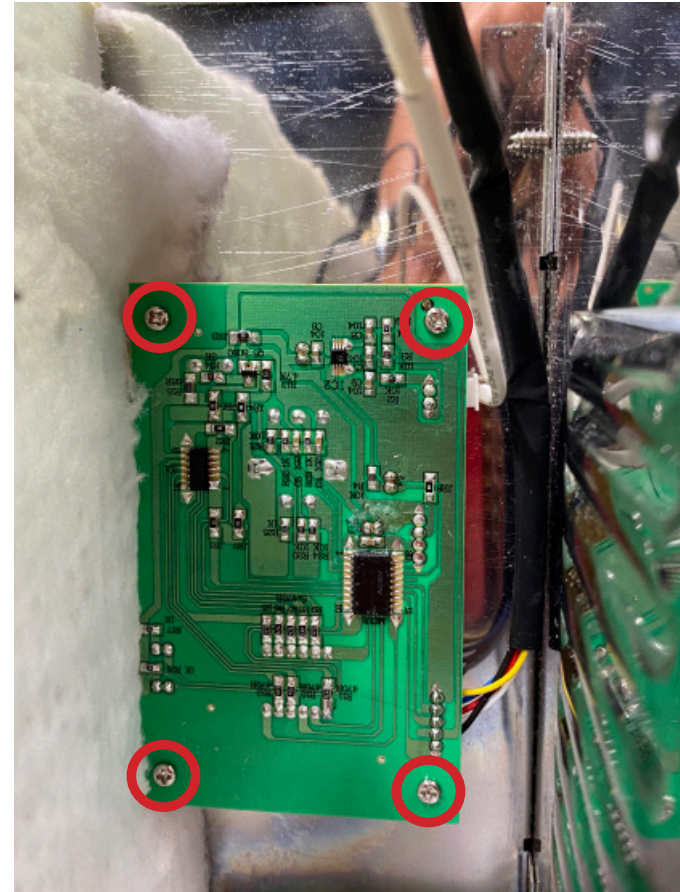

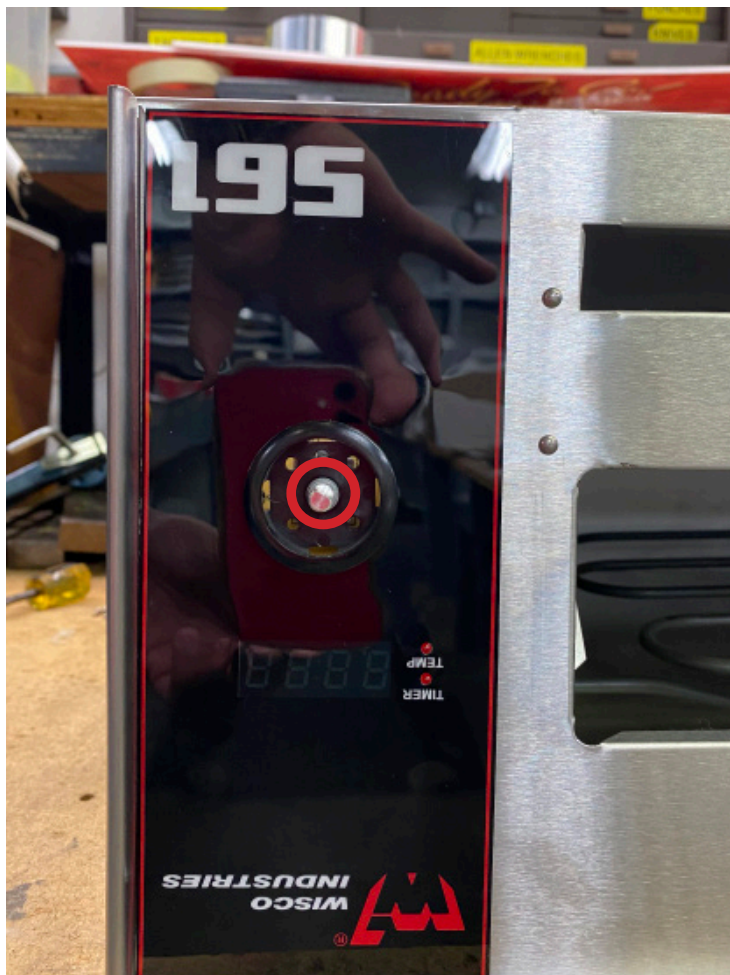
- 5** Remove (4) screws that hold the power board mount to the outer housing of the unit.



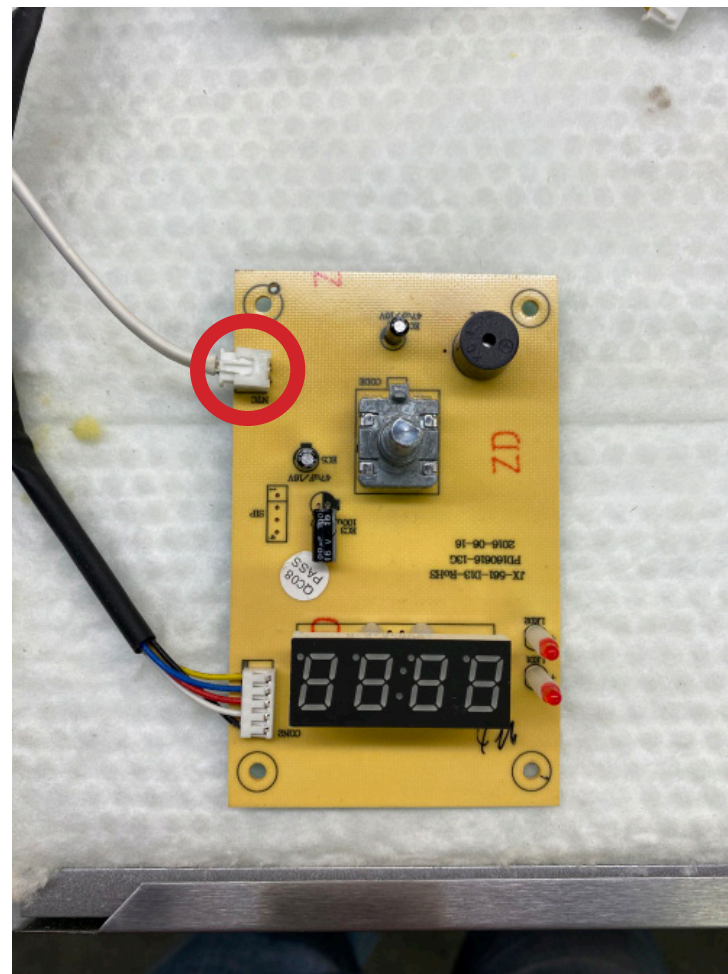
- 6** Unplug the control board from the power board and remove (4) screws holding the control board to the faceplate.



- 7** Push the control board out of its placement from the faceplate.



- 8** Unplug the white-coated wire from the board.
